Narrator of the story</p> <p>Ruth Werner - Russian spy</p> <p>Tell Hall -- physicist in Manhattan Project who gave secrets to Russia</p> <p>Haakon Chevalier - friend who approached Oppenheimer about spying for Russia. He was watched by the FBI, but he was not charged.</p>
